



## UNIFORM RULES

	<b>GIRLS</b>	<b>BOYS</b>
<b>BLAZER</b>	Black with new school crest badge Students in Years 8-11 are permitted to wear the black blazer with the old style badge, however when the blazer needs to be replaced the new style badged blazer must be purchased from School Togs	
<b>SHIRT/ BLOUSE</b>	Light blue with collar button for Years 7-10 White with collar button for Year 11	
<b>TIE</b>	New school crested tie available from School Togs Students in Years 8-11 are permitted to wear the old style tie (community tie), however when replacing the tie a new style tie must be purchased from School Togs.	
<b>JUMPER</b>	School black jumper with blue stripe or sleeveless jumper with blue stripe supplied by School Togs, or a plain black V neck jumper. No other style will be permitted. Cardigans are not permitted.	School black jumper with blue stripe or sleeveless jumper with blue stripe supplied by School Togs or plain black knitted jumper. No other style will be permitted.
<b>SKIRT/ TROUSER</b>	Compulsory black pleated skirts with school crest embroidered on waist band supplied by School Togs (no other type of skirt will be accepted)  Plain black trousers must have a waist band and be made of non-stretchy material Trousers in close fitting 'skinny' material are not allowed.	Plain black trousers (not denim) Trousers in close fitting 'skinny' material are not allowed.
<b>TIGHTS/SOCKS</b>	Girls who choose to wear a skirt are required to wear black, plain opaque tights. During the summer term only girls are permitted to wear natural coloured tights  Girls who chose to wear black school trousers must wear plain black socks	Plain black socks
<b>SHOES</b>	For health and safety reasons black, low heeled shoes (suede shoes, canvas or 'Vans', platform soles, trainers, boots and ankle boots are not acceptable).	For health and safety reasons black sensible shoes (suede shoes, platform soles, canvas or 'Vans'/trainers, boots and ankle boots are not acceptable).
<b>P.E. KIT</b>	Navy shorts Navy/Amber football socks Navy blue skirt White ankle socks Navy blue sweatshirt or dark tracksuit (optional) Navy blue hooded top (optional) Blue polo shirt with College logo Clean, non-marking trainers Clean underwear and a towel should always be brought and used as necessary. <b>Optional</b> Sports under layer	Black shorts with College logo Black rugby shirt with reversible white hoop Black football socks with 3 narrow white hoops Football/rugby boots White ankle socks White polo shirt with College logo Clean, non-marking trainers Clean underwear and a towel should always be brought and used as necessary. <b>Optional</b> Sports under layer

<b>HAIR</b>	Extreme or unconventional hairstyles for example 'hair tattoos' are not permitted, hair colours should be natural. If you are in any doubt please contact the College prior to your son/daughter changing their hairstyle. Head scarves worn for religious or cultural reasons should be plain and logo free.	
<b>OUTDOOR CLOTHING</b>	A plain outdoor coat or anorak -denim or leather jackets; hooded tops or tracksuit tops are not acceptable Scarves and hats worn to and from College should be logo free. A scarf in the College colours is available from 'Schooltogs'.	
<b>JEWELLERY</b>	A watch and one plain stud in the lobe of each ear is allowed. Students considering having their ears pierced should do so at the start of the summer holidays so that ears have time to heal and sleepers can be removed. Body jewellery (with the exception of one pair of ear studs) is not acceptable for health and safety reasons.	
<b>MAKE UP</b>	With the exception of Year 11, facial makeup and nail varnish are not allowed. In Year 11 only subtle facial makeup may be worn.	
<b>VALUABLES</b>	We do not recommend students to bring valuables into College and cannot take responsibility for replacing any such items that are lost, damaged, or stolen.	
<b>BAGS</b>	All bags should be practical and sensible for school use and should have the capacity to hold text books, folders and P.E. kit. Fashion bags, for example those with chains/handbags are <b>not</b> permitted.	

#### **OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED BY ALL STUDENTS**
